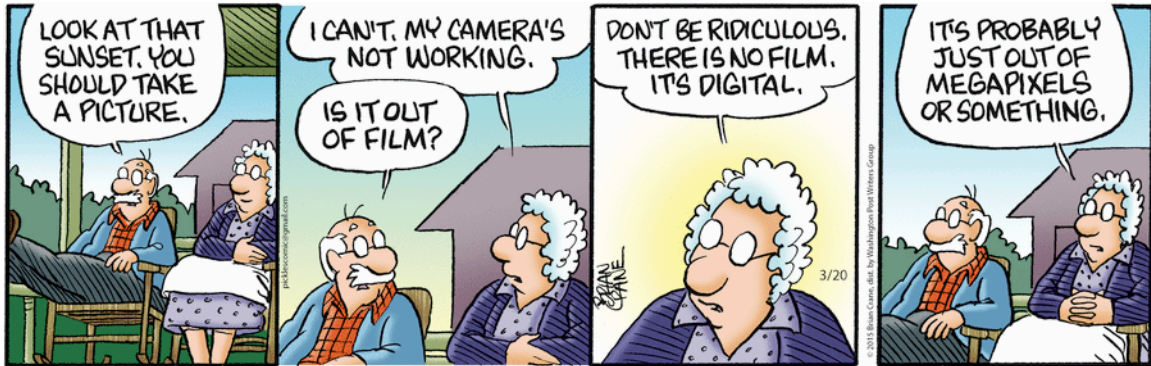

- All entries must be submitted to **Robin Young by the April 27, 2015 meeting.**
- **No Late entries will be accepted.**
- Presentation will be at the SBCC meeting on **May 11, 2015.**

S.H. Judging Criteria:

1-5 points for each photo based on the following:

- Includes the hunt subject
- Technical quality
- Play on words or Cleverness
- Originality

1 bonus point for use of a Theme

Max Points for all = 61

The judge(s) may discuss the reasoning for the points given.

The judge(s) may not speak to the photographer until after all the entries are judged and the photographer is revealed.

Remember - This is a fun contest - practice your photography skills!
