## Words from the Prez:

Will your digital photos last?

Right now the answer is "Don't Know". If you print them, photos will last for a long time if done properly. If you don't, will those "ones" and "zeros" be recognizable down the road? Nobody knows. If you keep copying digital photos to the latest media, you have a chance. But what about future generations. Will they care? If they do, your are in luck, otherwise, adios photos.

George Schaub writes in the December 2005 issue of Shutterbug – "print those images that are important to you, and that you think will be important touchstones for future generations. And don't abandon film or "traditional" prints, as it turns out, given proper processing and storage and given failure to back up or print digitally originated images, that these may be the most permanent image records of all. No one suggests you print every digital photo, just as you don't save a majority of prints made on film. But making sure that future generations will have the ability to visually connect with their past is part of your job as a photographer."
