**Directions to Barnsdall:** There are obviously several ways to go but one way is the 405N to the 105E to the 110N to the 101N. Get off at Vermont. Go right onto N. Vermont to Hollywood Blvd. Go left and Barnsdall will be on your left.

**Directions to Umami:** From Barnsdall go right on Hollywood Blvd to 4655 Hollywood Blvd. Its about a 5 minute walk or a few minutes by car. They do not have a parking lot but the manager told me that at that time of day there is plenty of street parking.
