And what a show (official competition) it was on September 22nd! A large crowd enjoyed 34 digital images, color and monochrome, projected brilliantly on a large screen. The image quality was similar to a computer screen, where the original images were manipulated from scanned film or digital camera sources.

Phil Cohen, our Website Chairman, deserves a lot of credit, also, for developing a technique that enabled the image makers to easily transform their photos to the projection team. Our Sept. 8 meeting was used to demonstrate our new Website and explain the entry procedures. Phil's Website, www.sbccphoto.org, should be home base for all members on the Internet.

This issue of the SBCC Bulletin includes the scores of our first Projected Image contest, as well as the results of the two print contests. Prints are a major part of photography, enhancing all printed media. Our club has been repeatedly commended for the quality of prints in our competitions.
