Notes on Calendar Entries:

October 8, Monday --- Print Evaluation:

Annie Appel will be our evaluator for this evening of prints. She has provided print evaluation for us on several occasions in the past and is well known. The new print rules as printed last month will be in effect.

October 23, Tuesday --- John Bohner Memorial Fantasy Print Night:

Bring your weird, funny, and/or manipulated photographs. Use montage, use Photoshop, use Illustrator, whatever. Anything goes. We want to honor the photographic spirit of our colleague John. But be prepared to explain your images. There will be no evaluator in the usual sense. Limit is 2 photographs per member.

November 12, Monday --- Digital Evaluation:

The originally scheduled evaluator, Mark Comon, had to reschedule his appearance due to time conflicts. He will present a program on November 26 (see below). As a result, there will be no theme for this November 12 Digital Evaluation. The evaluator will be photographer David Duenas making his first appearance at SBCC. David's career in photography covers many areas including photographing for the Disney Studios and doing portraits for a multitude of clients.

November 26, Monday --- Program: Filters for Digital Photography

Mark Comon of Paul's Photo will present a program on the use of filters for digital photography. He will cover filters used on the camera as well as "filters" applied in the computer via an image editing program. This should be of interest to all digital photographers.

December 10, Monday --- Holiday Banquet ---

The banquet will take place at the Sizzler Restaurant on Sepulveda Blvd. in Torrance. There will be raffle prizes and member slide shows. Slide shows are limited to 3 minutes duration. January 14, Monday --- Print Evaluation, Monochrome

This will be a normal print evaluation evening with the exception that all entries must be monochrome. Monochrome does not necessarily mean black/white. Instead of black, the single color could be sepia, red, blue, whatever. Various shades are easily applied using a computer and image editing software. The evaluator for this program is TBA.

January 28, Monday --- Program: Collecting and presenting a body of work --- the Occupy Project

Annie Appel will tell of her adventures in photographing participants in the Occupy movement in several cities. She will talk about various aspects of the project such as finance, photographing, production, and distribution of the book.
