Thru Aug 24	Meteor showers	The Perseid meteor shower, one of the most anticipated of the year, overlaps with the Delta Aquarids this year. Peak dates from around Aug.11-13. Earthsky advises those who are serious about seeing meteors not to be daunted. Instead, start watching for the Perseids in the pre-dawn hours from Friday, Aug. 9, through Sunday, Aug. 11. On those dates, there will be more moon-free viewing time than during the peak dates.
